
Hierarchical navigation through archives and fonds down to individual charters. Charters are a combination from images and diplomatic metadata.

Images can be annotated with metadata and parts of images can be combined to image collections.

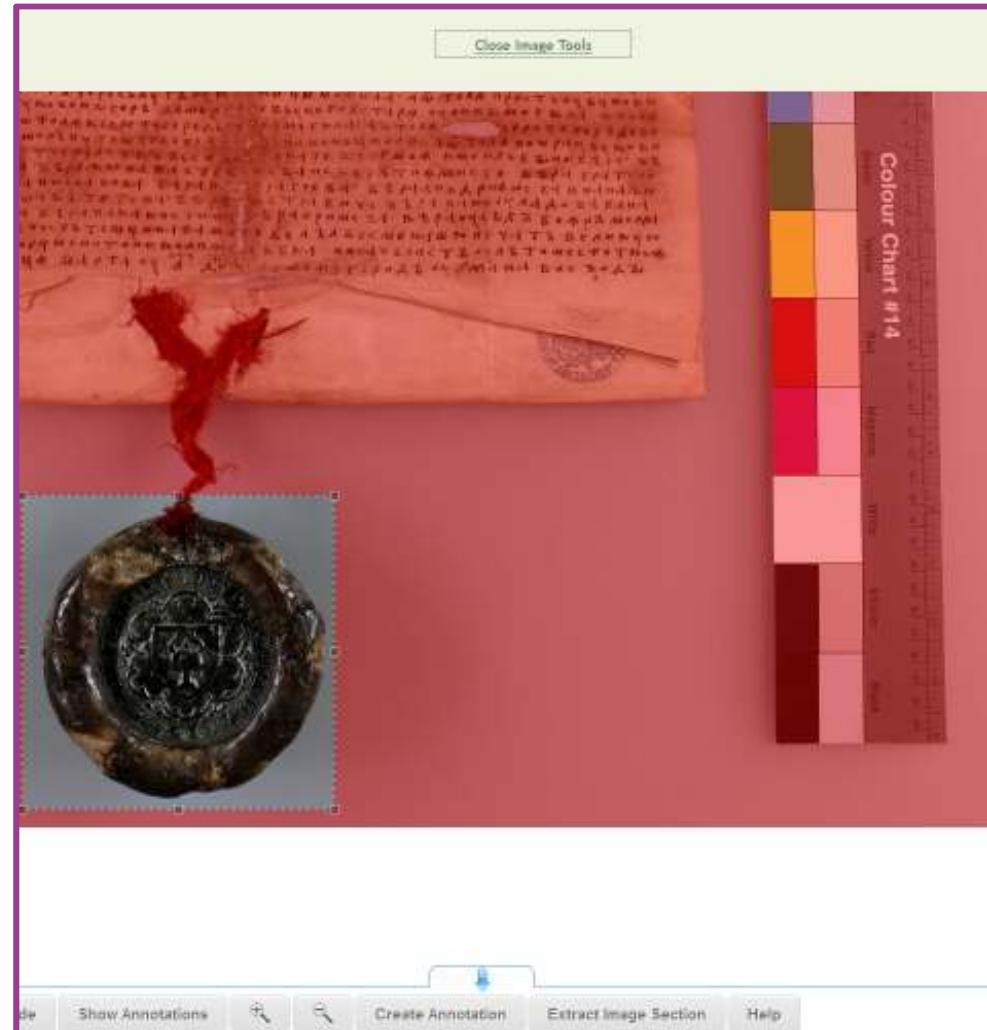




Image collections

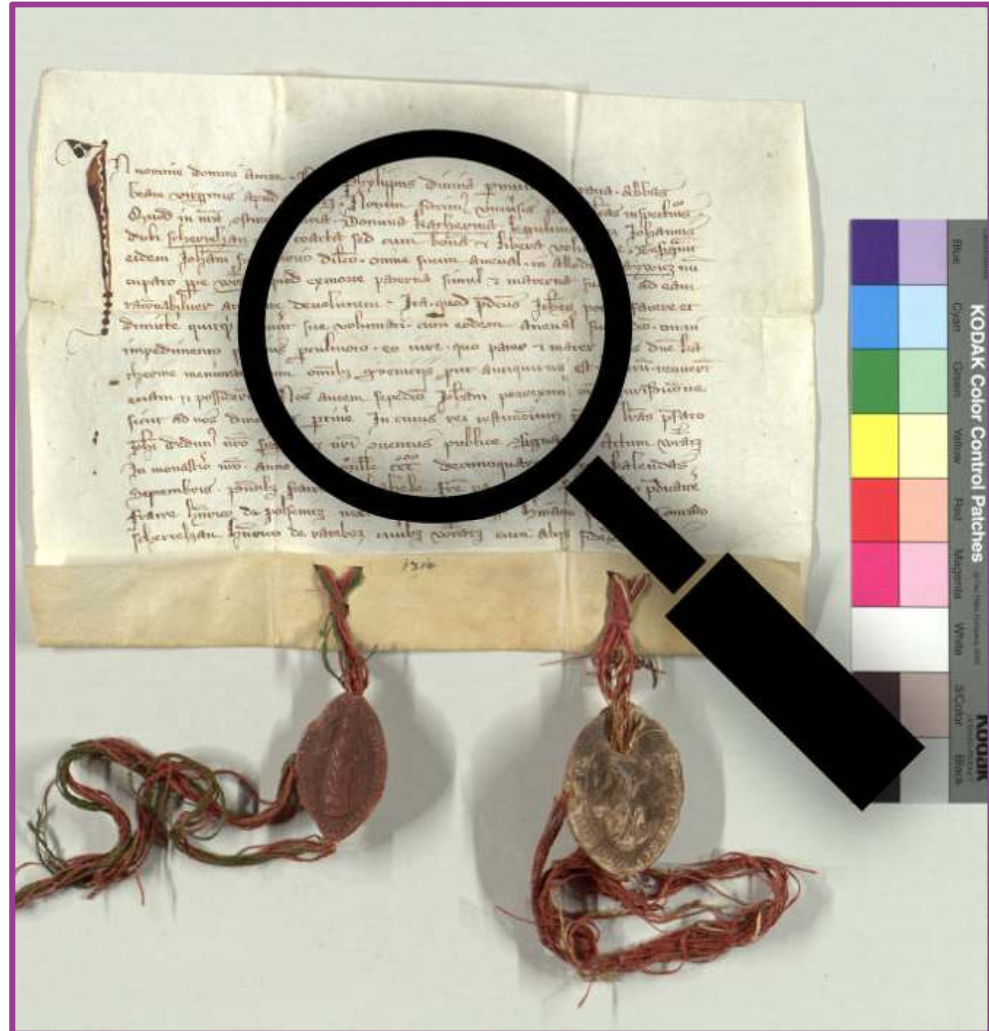

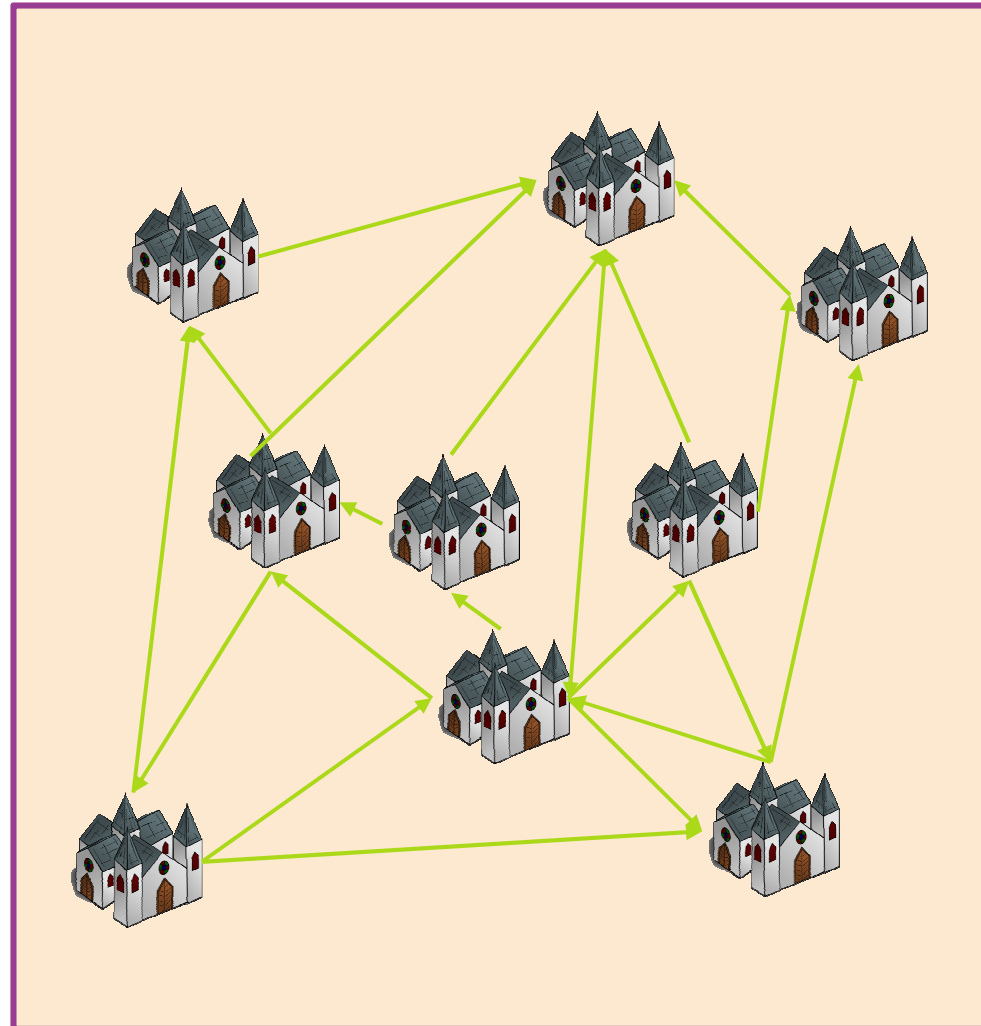
